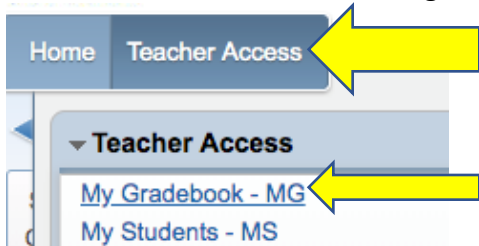


Setting Up Gradebook – Category Average - Skyward

1. Log in to Skyward
2. Click on Teacher Access and go down to My Gradebook



3. Click Gradebook for one of your classes.

4. Click on Categories on your toolbar at the top.



5. The gradebook should be defaulted to Total Points. You can change this by clicking Change Score Method on the top right side of your screen. Change this to “Base grades on percents assigned to categories.”
 6. A preselected list of Categories will be listed on your screen. If you would like to add/edit this list, click Add/Edit Categories on the right side of your screen.
- **Remember, these Categories only help you to organize your gradebook. All of your grades will still be calculated using total points.
7. At this time, it appears you can only add or remove the predefined Categories. Add the percentage weights to your Categories. When you are finished, click Save.

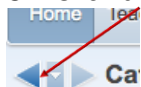

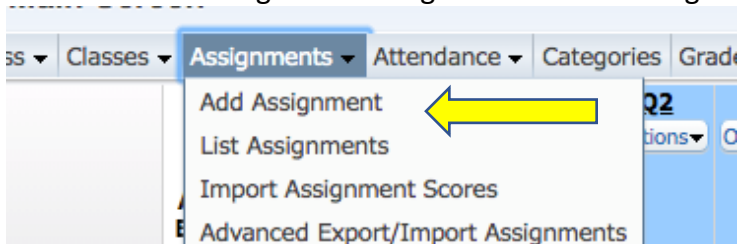
